Benefit	Co-Pay	Description
Primary medical care	\$0	Clinicians with expertise in caring for seniors.
Specialty medical care	\$0	Specialty medical care such as cardiology, pulmonology and orthopedics, as needed.
Dental/Vision/Hearing/Foot care	\$0	Preventive care and curative treatment per your care plan.
Coordinated care and customized care planning	\$0	Based on your unique needs and health care goals.
Medications, medical supplies and equipment	\$0	Includes prescription and over-the-counter medications and all necessary medical supplies.
In-home care	\$0	Personal care in your home, such as assistance with bathing, dressing, and housekeeping.
Home health care	\$0	Includes in-home nursing care and rehabilitation services.
Supportive housing	\$0	Partnerships with all levels of care, including assisted living, residential care, adult care homes and memory care facilities.
Adult day center	\$0	Health and social center visits for meals, activities and social support.
Physical, occupational and speech therapy	\$0	All rehabilitation therapy is offered per your care plan.
Hospitalizations and medical procedures	\$0	Includes in-patient and out-patient care.
Transportation	\$0	Transportation, coordinated by your care team, to and from the health and social centers and medical appointments.
Emergency and urgent care	\$0	All emergency care and 24/7 on-call provider coverage.

Who is eligible?

PacificSource PACE is for people who are

- Age 55 or older
- Eligible for Medicaid or Medicare (or can pay privately)
- Live in Lane County (excluding ZIP codes 97498, 97439, 97493, 97390, 97480, 97430, 97324, 97490, 97461)
- Need long-term care services as defined by the state of Oregon, such as help with daily health or personal care
- Are willing to receive all their health services through PacificSource PACE
- Can live safely in the community with help from the program



Participants do not need to be PacificSource members to be eligible.
